

**SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES FOR THE MEETING OF THE WOOL INDUSTRY EDP USERS  
GROUP HELD ON WEDNESDAY THE 29<sup>th</sup> OF JANUARY 2014**

**SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES**

**1. EDI Catalogues – Validation of Sale Roster**

NCWSBA accepted the proposed solution.

ACWEP and PTWMA accepted the proposed solution.

WIEDPUG will be issuing the selling centre/types codes to ensure control of the codes being used.

A suggestion was made that the PC document could handle the issue. This would have several implications such as some rewording of the handbook required and some possible legal implications for public versus private catalogue usage.

An email submission from AWH accepted the proposed solution however would like to know the validation rules for auction catalogue transmissions to the EDI network.

AWTA accepted the proposed solution as AWTA systems accept whatever is transmitted in the Sale Identity field.

The email submission from Talman stated that the preferred solution was to use the PC document, the second option was to support the recommendation of the working group.

The email submission from NZWTA accepted the proposal but would like to reserve the codes N & C for NZ selling centres.

AWEX's position was a preference for the PC document to be used however would accept the proposed solution from the working group.

The proposed solution summary is to break up the sale identity definition and defining selling centre/type in the data dictionary with codes being reserved. The group agreed with summary.

An enquiry was made as to whether the AC document would need to mention that sales are validated against a sale roster. The group decided that this would be a private matter between the selling provider and the network provider and not covered in the standards.

All historical selling centre codes since 1995 would need to be reserved.

The proposed changes from the working group have been accepted and will be included in the next handbook release.

**2. EDI Catalogues – RISK catalogue section**

This item was withdrawn.

**3. Next Handbook Release Date**

The handbook release date will be 21 July 2014, it will be a point release and the new version will be 30.4

#### **4. Other Business**

The group was advised of a submission regarding recent updates to the NWD and the Mulesing Status. The only change made was to the printed form, all of the NWD codes remained the same and there are no changes required to the data transmissions.
