How to Complete the NWD

- To declare the DMFR and/or Mulesing Status for each mob (and line of wool) the **Owner/Manager**, in consultation with the **Woolclasser**, must:
 - Answer the question “**Has Mulesing Ceased on this Property?**”
 - Complete all the **NWD Mob questions** (Mob No., Age, Breed, Sex, Shedding Breeds, Crutching and Mulesing Status).
 - **Sign and date the declaration.**
- The **Woolclasser** will complete the rest of the specification, **including the Mob Number column**, for all lines of wool (including oddments).

- Note 1:** If Mulesing has Ceased on the property, for mobs that have been declared Mulesed (or left the box left blank), CM will be allocated to the associated lines of wool.
- Note 2:** If Mulesing has not Ceased on the property, for mobs that have been declared Mulesed (or left the box left blank), Blank will be allocated to the associated lines of wool.
- Note 3:** Not Declared (ND) will be recorded for mobs (and associated lines of wool) where the DMFR and/or the Mulesing declaration is left blank (i.e. the CM question has not been answered and the mob DMFR and Mulesing Status questions are blank or incomplete).

NWD Definitions

1 Mulesing	The removal of skin from the breech and/or tail of a sheep using mulesing shears. <i>Source:</i> Australian Animal Welfare Standards and Guidelines for Sheep (draft)
2 Ceased Mulesing (CM)	Wool from sheep where <u>mulesing has ceased on the property</u> . No lambs born on the property in the last 12 months have been mulesed at the time of this shearing.
3 Non Mulesed (NM)	<u>No sheep</u> in this mob has been mulesed.
4 Pain Relief (PR)	All sheep in this mob have been <u>mulesed using a registered Pain Relief product</u> . Note: PR must be declared separately for each mob (it is <u>not</u> a property declaration).
5 Mulesed (M)	<u>Some/all sheep</u> in this mob <u>have been</u> mulesed.
6 Shedding Breeds	Breeds that shed fibre (e.g. Afrikaner, Australian White, Awassi, Damara, Dorper, Karakul, Meatmaster, Persian, Van Rooy, Wiltipoll, Wiltshire Horn).
7 Contact with Shedding Breeds	Mated to, or run in the same paddock as shedding sheep/lambs or their crosses.

By signing this declaration, I warrant that (a) I am authorised to complete this declaration and confirm that all details contained in it are true and correct, (b) I authorise the selling agent to submit this document to AWEX (if requested) for the purpose of the Integrity Program, and (c) I understand that I may be subject to random desk audits and on farm inspections, the results of which may be made available to the buyers of the declared wool and the selling agent.
