Online wool classer registration status check

AWEX is pleased to advise it has released two online facilities to enable third parties to check the registration status of a wool classer.

Individual

This option would typically be used by a wool grower, shearing contractor or selling agent wanting to validate the current registration status of an individual wool classer.

This can be found on the AWEX web site www.awex.com.au by locating the Wool Classer Validation page under the Wool Classer tab, or alternatively by using this direct link: www.awex.com.au/woolclasser/wool-classer-validation/

By entering the stencil number and the last name of the person, one of the following responses will be returned:

- The wool classer is currently registered.
- The wool classer is currently unregistered.
- The wool classer is not registered to class. (This means the wool classer is currently registered as a Classer Associate but is not registered to class.)
- No matching result. (This means there is no record matching the input number and last name.)

Batch submissions

For companies, such as wool brokers or handling agents, wanting to validate the status of multiple wool classer stencils via a batch, AWEX has released a web service option. This is a secured system-to-system facility that allows a company to submit multiple stencils at a time (e.g. those stencils in a pre-sale catalogue) with the AWEX service providing a return status on each stencil in the submission.
