# SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES FOR THE MEETING OF THE WOOL INDUSTRY EDP USERS GROUP HELD ON TUESDAY THE 12<sup>th</sup> OF OCTOBER 2022

## SUMMARY OF OUTCOMES

## 1. Brand Details in Combination Request

- 1.1. NZWTA are receiving electronic combination requests from customers. The clients need a specific brand, at the moment they cannot include any brand details, need to add an 80 record.
- 1.2. There is a requirement of an 80 record following the 58 record in the TCR, it would be optional and only for NZ, it will be part of the R1 loop.

## 2. Standards Review Update

- 2.1. Phase 1 of the project started on the 4th of October. All relevant information from the project will be passed onto to WIEDPUG representatives. This information will need to be distributed to relevant organisations and contacts by WIEDPUG representatives.
- 2.2. The summary of the high level data exchange requirements compiled from the responses received from this group along with contact details of this group have been passed onto Jade. Meetings with Jade will be arranged for all representatives.

## 3. General Updates

- 3.1. EDI Subscribers EDI/FTP Passwords
  - 3.1.1. There is still about a third of users that have not changed passwords. What is the requirement from WIEDPUG to move forward on this issue.
  - 3.1.2. Talman are happy for clients to be provided and they will follow them up.
- 3.2. Wool Industry Organisation Code Extracts
  - 3.2.1. Hold over to the next meeting.
- 3.3. Classer stencil numbers in the TRV and LI
  - 3.3.1. Currently some wool arrives at the core line without a hard copy speci. AWTA has proposed a business rule for when the wool arrives at the core line without a hard copy speci. Trying to come up with a national approach to issuing certificate types at the core line. No EDI changes required.

## 3.4. ABN in the LI

3.4.1. If a classer number is not known a check is done as to who owns the wool. A proposal is being considered to look at tracking classer numbers and ABN's as the wool moves through the pipeline. The EDI formats may need to allow for the ABN to be included in the future.

#### 4. Other Business

- 4.1. Packing lists
  - 4.1.1. There are currently four different packing lists formats. Would be good to have a standard format. Possibly include this in the Jade review.
