## Release Notes – Version 1.1

### Web Site

#### Renewal of Wool Classer Registration

- Users who are registered wool classers will be able to renew their registration for the 2019-21 period using WoolClip.
- When the renewal period is opened, a [wool classer](#) user will initially be taken to renewal screen when logging in. The wool classer may choose to renew their registration at this time or click on the [\[Re-register Later – Go to WoolClip\]](#) button found in the top right corner. Wool classers who do choose to re-register are given an option on completion to [\[Proceed to WoolClip\]](#).
- Where Re-registration has been skipped, the wool classer user shall see a Re-Registration Alert message on their Dashboard (replacing the weather widget).

#### Addressing

- The input fields for Town/State and Postcode have been simplified on Registration, Farm Account, Farm Location, Job and Specification Forms.

#### Job Details

- *Job Type* has been removed.
- *Shed Weight* will default to Net.
- *Pack Condition* will default to New.
- *Pack Type* will default to Nylon.
- *Cut Out Date* has been moved to Specification Form.
- *Trading Name* details have been moved to Specification Form.
- *Shed Bale Weight* and *Bale Weight Units* can no longer be edited if bales have been added to the Wool Book.

#### Team

- A Carrier role has been added.

#### Mob

- A message will display when a user tries to change mob details if the mob is on a Finalised Specification.

#### NWD


- The *Date declared* and *Declared by* (name) is now visible against the Property and Mob levels.

## Bale (Wool Book)

- A new [\[Print\]](#) button will allow the user to print a local copy of the Wool Book.
- Bug fix. XXXX can now be selected as a *Line* code.
- 2 new Bale Description *Breed* codes have been added (refer 2019-21 Code of Practice).
- Bale Description *Line* and *Wool Category* codes have been re-sequenced to match the 2019-21 Code of Practice.
- A message will display where the user tries to change a bale when it is on a Specification.

## Specification

- A [\[Trading Details\]](#) button has been added to the Specification page (See 1 on image below). On click the user can add or edit *Trading Details* prior to Finalisation. If the Job has been linked to a Farm Account using a Wool-ID then the linked Farm Account details will be viewable.
- The Trading Name and Wool-ID cannot be edited on a Job if a Finalised Specification exists.
- An NWD warning status message will appear on the Specification Form if the NWD has yet to be declared.
- A new field *Has Shearing Finished?* has been added. If Yes is optioned, then a *Cut out date* field is displayed (See 2 and 3 on image below).
- The local [\[Print\]](#) version of the Specification has been improved slightly in appearance. *Remember – this local print is not intended to be presentation quality.*
- A Finalised Specification will now also be auto-emailed to Owner/Manager(s) or Marketing Rep(s) in the Team.
- Minor cosmetic enhancements, e.g. a line added to separate total bales (in a line) from individual bale numbers.



## Auditing

- Audit logging has been enhanced.

## Phone App

- Performance and response time improvement on Android phones.
- Improved stability and bug fixes.

**Important:** For this version update please uninstall the WoolClip App on your phone and re-install from the App store to get the most recent version (Version 1.1 on the login page). Your data will be retrieved from the WoolClip servers when you reopen in the new version. If you stay on the old version errors are likely to occur.

## Next Release

The next October release will include:

- A full training site for wool classing students. This allow users who are not yet registered wool classers to practice using the site.
- A “Shed mode” switch for the phone App. This will allow the user to manually switch off the synchronising function when in an area of marginal reception.
