

Prior to July 2019, Pack Material and Pack Condition was reported in EDI and hardcopy catalogues using Catalogue Symbols. To allow these important variables to be included in a wider range of documents, from July 2019 they are now reported using specific fields.

Pack Material Codes

Code	Condition/Denotes
N	Nylon Packs (complete lots only)
E	Experimental Packs
J	Jute packs (complete lots or lots that contain portions of Nylon and/or HDPE 5 and/or HDPE 1 and Jute packs)
K	HDPE1 packs (complete lots or lots that contain portions of Nylon and/or HDPE 5 and HDPE 1 packs)

Where a line/lot contains a Pack with a lower Material, the lower Material shall apply. The hierarchy from highest to lowest is N, E, J, K.

Printed catalogue condition: The code for Nylon packs shall not be printed (but shall be transmitted).

Pack Condition Codes

Code	Condition/Denotes
N	New Pack (not previously used)
M	Marked (not previously cored and grabbed)
R	Repaired (previously core and/or grabbed and repaired)
X	Not repaired (previously cored and/or grabbed) (excl reoffer)

Where a line/lot contains a Pack with a lower condition, the lower condition shall apply. The hierarchy from highest to lowest is N, M, R, X.

Printed catalogue condition: The condition code for New packs shall not be printed (but shall be transmitted).
